Where does my £1 go?

Many drivers are unaware of the work done by the ORCi Safety Group. This elected group consists of the ORCi Chairman, Philip Bond, former Incarace promoter, and three other members including Brian Smith, ORCi Track Inspector. They meet by telephone conference regularly, and review events that may have occurred and make recommendations to the ORCi for Rule Changes. The group has been busy this year dealing with two fatal accidents, Dave Weare at Hednesford in September 2011, and Steve Newman in June 2012. Both of these accidents will have consequences, and as yet there is no resolution between Cannock Council and Incarace over drivers exiting cars during races, so the work goes on to try and make the sport safer, and yet exciting and appealing to spectators. Stopping races every time a driver needs to exit is no use, and we are working to persuade the Council that there is a better way. Those of you who have raced at Hednesford will be aware that it is **compulsory** now to attend driver's briefing, where wrist bands are given to prove it, without which you cannot race. All



drivers must attend these briefings, and every meeting someone comes to me on the pits gate and asks a question that has been covered at briefing!

The £1 levy is used to fund anything that helps the safety of the sport, including a rolling programme of staff training and certification, inspection and improvement of tracks, and distribution of safety information.
