### **Brisca F2 Stock Cars**

We have had tremendous support from the stock cars this year, as you would expect from a Semi Final year, and a West Country World Final, and finishing off with the Rookies Reward Final, with a bigger than usual grid, although it was very disappointing that while every driver qualifying was sent a personal letter, many failed to notify us that they were not going to attend. We shall continue the series in 2014, and, more importantly, unlike other tracks, keep it just for whites and yellows only! Congratulations to Alex Sloggett for his Endeavour Trophy win, and his season was the epitome of qualification criteria-lots of effort for little reward!

Looking back on the Semi Finals, it was very disappointing that miserable weather reduced the crowd for what was a very watchable meeting that had everything for the stock car fan, including the clashes between Rob Speak and Chris Bradbury, and some wily driving from Gordon Moodie. It set the scene for a very memorable World Final at Taunton, that showed the sport at its very, very best. Our staff and ourselves did our best to run the Semi Finals that we would all like to have been at watching, or racing in, and it seemed that most people agreed with they way it went.

As this is written there is a referendum ongoing to decide what tyres should be used for the next three years. There has been much debate, and Brisca f2 has given every drivers as much information as possible to make an informed decision, and we hope that you have all used your vote.

We look forward to welcoming all F2 drivers and fans to the Dinner Dance on Saturday February 8th 2014, especially Chris Bradbury to celebrate his unprecedented sixth Points Championship victory, despite being unable to take part in the final meeting due to illness.

Tickets this year are £28 for a three course dinner and live band, plus reduced room rates at the Hotel for overnight stay.

As for 2014, we are pleased to confirm that we will be running an important meeting for drivers, the Benevolent Fund Trophy. In conjunction with Sharon Blood, who does an extraordinary job in fundraising, we hope to come up with some ideas to enhance your fund, and encourage the top flight drivers to support the meeting. It is a bit too soon to be able to tell you the dates for 2014, but three that are definite are the World Qualifier on Easter Sunday, the Pink Ribbon Trophy on July 27<sup>th</sup>, and the Ben Fund on October 5<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Bangers**

There has been a lot of debate this year about National Banger car construction rules, and there is a feeling among promoters that it is time for change. Four open forum meetings with drivers are in the process of being held-two have already taken place at Mildenhall and in the south west, with two more planned in the Midlands and the East Coast. We were very disappointed that only three Mendips Raceway drivers turned up for the south west meeting, plus around ten from Autospeed. The consensus from the drivers was that a more uniform approach to scrutineering was the key, and from the promoters side, that a simplification of the car construction rules was required to reduce the time taken and expense of preparing cars. When all the meetings have taken place, the ORCi will decide what the way forward will be.

Well done to Tom Davey for his National Banger points Championship, and to a very surprised Chris Neville for winning the Rookies prize, plus a trip to Ipswich for the Rookie World Final. As always, the points championship is awarded to the highest scoring Mendips Raceway registered driver, not the highest overall scorer.
